

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IMPORTANT/PRECAUTIONS: The UFX GLOBAL Silver-Bullet equipment creates very fine particles. These particles are capable of setting off a fire alarm. The cold dry fog produced will not set off a heat activated sprinkler system. It is recommended that you cover smoke detectors, contact local fire department and/or shut down the fire protection system with proper permission.

NOTICE TO APPLICATOR: When prolonged exposure to spray mist occurs, wear protective eyewear (goggles, face shield, or glasses), gloves, long sleeve shirt, pants, and shoes plus socks. To avoid any unpleasant drying of the nose and throat when applying in confined areas or when prolonged exposure to spray mist occurs, wear a pesticide respirator with an organic-vapor removing cartridge with pre-filter approved for pesticides. (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-23C), or a canister approved for pesticides (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-14G), or a NIOSH approved respirator with an organic vapor (OV) removing cartridge or canister with any R, P, or HE pre-filter.

INDOOR TREATMENT: BED BUGS

Procedure:

1. Prepare the room: Remove all bedding from mattresses and box springs. Remove clothes and linens from closets, armchairs, chests, nightstands, and dresser drawers. If possible, remove drapery and window treatments. Place all clothes, fabrics, and linen items in plastic bags and have them laundered.
2. Inspect every crack and crevice, around baseboards, floorboards, headboards, and walls. Inspect potential harborage sites and migration paths behind picture frames, in cabinet drawers, bookcases, etc. Vacuum as many bed bugs you can visibly see. Note locations of heavily infested areas.
3. Use vacuum to suck up all the bed bugs and bed bug eggs you can find, particularly on the mattresses and box springs.
4. Treat small void areas such as outlets with an insecticidal dust labeled for that use.
5. Apply a residual insecticide spray to cracks and crevices according to the instructions on the label.
6. Lift the mattress and box springs and place together like an A-Frame or Teepee. Open all furniture doors, drawers and closet doors.
7. Aquariums and fish bowls must be covered or removed and any pet animals should be removed from the area being treated.
8. Use according to one of the two options listed below.

OPTION #1 (BED BUGS): Space Spray:

Place the Silver-Bullet in the center of the room. Fill the Silver-Bullet reservoir to the correct level using the sight measuring instrument on the side of the unit. Turn the unit to the "ON" position, and allow unit to fog the room. For correct application time for the size of room, please refer to the Silver-Bullet manual. Rule of thumb: 6-8 fluid ounces per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Vacate the room for 60 minutes. Ventilate room before re-entry.

OPTION #2 (BED BUGS): Targeted Direct Spray:

Fill the Silver-Bullet with 6-8 fluid ounces of HOLLOW POINT S-B Insecticide Spray. Attach the target treatment hose included with your Silver-Bullet unit or (OPTIONAL) The Unifix Patriot injection wand. Tighten hose to coupling on the unit. Turn the unit to the "ON" position. Fog will flow from the end of the target hose or injection wand. Guide the hose under and direct the fog into all seams of the bedding, box spring, bed board, bed frame, under and on furniture, in drawers and along drawer frames, behind picture frames, along all molding and trim of doors, floors, and ceilings. Vacate room for 60 minutes. Ventilate room before re-entry.
